

# SIERRA MADRE HUNTING RESORT

Featuring the best hunting area of Mexico for Trophy Coues White-Tailed deer and Mearns (Montezuma, Harlequin or Painted) Quail, at the foot hills of the famous Sierra del Nido in Chihuahua.

One of the last corners of the world with grizzly bears (see National Geographic video on grizzlies), it has also produced the 2nd and 4th highest ranking Coues Deer for typical antlers and 10 of the first 17 top rankings for non-typical antlers listed in *Safari International's* 1994 Record Book Of Trophy Animals. Chances for a trophy are very good.



Our 25,000 acre ranch is located right in the heart of this area. *Deer hunting was not permitted for the last 25 years.* We opened for the first time in autumn of 1997.

We also have the famous Mearns Quail considered "The Gentleman's Hunt". A sport of courtesy and fine dogs. The bird is so beautiful that few hunters resist the temptation of having their kill

mounted as a precious token to their loved ones. We can provide taxidermy service also.

Both hunts can be performed comfortably on foot or horse. Our terrain is one part open rolling hills with thick grasses ideal for quail and the rest consists of medium thick oak forest.

At our altitude and with mostly year round clear skies, the bright sun delivers a comfortable day. At night stars are so bright they illuminate the heavens with joy.

The ranch is owned and operated by a large family who value the land, its people, animals and guests. Of it's



fifteen members, six participate in providing all the services from your arrival to your departure. Our objective is to assure an extraordinary level of satisfaction with personal service, comfortable facilities and a guided quality hunt.

We will delight you with international and Mexican style dishes cooked with organic ingredients where possible. We use our own 🍷 beef, pasture raised chickens and locally produced bread, butter, cheese etc....

Our cold blue sweet drinking water is extracted from deep wells, filtered by millions of microscopic cells of basalt rock. Every visitor wants to take a bottle home, and we allow it!
